New child health bill would save many lives

Jim Driggers' excellent letter on the importance of helping the poor, not only in the United States but worldwide, couldn't be more timely.

Recently, children traveled hundreds of miles, alone, to reach the United States for a better life. And more than 800 desperate people died in the Mediterranean Sea trying to get to Europe's safe shores.
